<p>- Natures colours: collect different coloured leaves and put on the tuff spot. What colours can you see? Can you find add more colours to the tuff spot (Feathers, shells, etc.)? -Children explore colours by playing with coloured rice on a tuff spot -Make a Bonfire picture (Guy Fawkes 5<sup>th</sup> Nov)</p>	<p><b>Elmer the elephant</b> -Wow Starter: <b>Balloons – lots of balloons and lots of colours (08/11/22)</b> -Children create a rainbow for the display board in the classroom - Shaving foam and powder paint. Children mix both together and explore texture and colour change</p>	<p><b>Elmer the elephant</b> - Make a rainbow picture: children paint one side of picture and then fold it to make a mirror image - children explore different coloured orbs (Jelly balls) - Display slices of different fruits and vegetables in zip lock bags for children to observe and explore</p>	<p><b>Rainbow fish</b> - Provide different coloured pompoms and tweezers. Let the children sort the materials into colours - Children make cakes using cornflakes and melted chocolate and topping it with colourful sprinkles</p>	<p><b>Rainbow fish</b> - Marble painting: children observe what happens to the colours when they mix -Making rainbow fish collages <b>Forest school- Children explore natures colours finding natural things in the field (24/11/22)</b></p>	<p><b>The Christmas truck</b> -FOS Finale: <b>Christmas Art and Crafts (07/12/22)</b> - Making Christmas cards with children - What makes Christmas so special for the children? -Who celebrates Christmas? Why do we celebrate Christmas (Story, the owl and the star) - mark making: bags filled with different coloured paint on tuff spot</p>	<p><b>Goodnight Santa</b> -Children explore colours by making Christmas decorations using glue, sparkling materials and glitter -Making Christmas biscuits - What is your favourite colour? - Children decorate Christmas tree - children ‘write’ out their own Christmas card</p>
